This is a wonderful time to gather our global community, to connect with deep expertise and like-minded passionate people in order to focus on the power of GEN- credibility, capability and community.






Last but not least, we will gather as a community.

Time-Zone

Cologne time uses the Central European Summer Time (UTC+2) in International Time Zone. NOTE: on the 29th of October the time zone will change to Central European Time (UTC+1)

Voltage

Standard supply voltage in Cologne is 230V. We suggest bringing a EU/Germany travel adaptor.

Currency

The currency used in Cologne is Euros, abbreviated to EUR. You can change Euros at banks, airports and hotels. You often find cash as the most acceptable form of payment however, cards are still widely being used.

Weather

In late October, the weather in Cologne is typically chilly with temperatures averaging 7-13°C (45-55°F). There may be rainy days so pack accordingly.

Here are some items we suggest you consider packing:

- Layers such as thermal tops, sweaters, long sleeve shirts
- Comfortable warm pants
- Rain Jacket/Umbrella
- Comfortable shoes
- Hat, gloves and scarf

With a 4.3 Star Rating on google, this restaurant is only a 7 minute walk from the academy. This restaurant has vegetarian options and is open quite late.

• Kiki's Imbiss

A shopping mall that is a 6 min drive from the academy.








By bus and rail.

FROM COLOGNE CENTRAL STATION

You may take the underground (lines 16 or 18) to Neumarkt to change there to tram 7 to Zündorf, and get off at the Raiffeisenstraße stop. From there, it is about 7 minutes to walk to the headquarters. Alternatively, you can go by tram 1 or 9 towards Brück or Königsforst, and get off at the station Deutz/Messe stop.

FROM DEUTZ STADION (BF DEUTZ/LANXESS ARENA)

You may take bus 196 going direct to TÜV Rheinland (see time of departure).

FROM FAR-AWAY PLACES

From the motorway ring road take the A 4 as far as the Gremberg motorway intersection, then take the A 559 towards Deutz and leave at the Kalk/-Poll exit; continue along Rolshover Straße, Max-Glomsda-Straße and Am Grauen Stein, until you get to TÜV Rheinland.

FROM NEAR-AWAY PLACES

If you know your way around, you may go straight through the city centre, cross one of the Rhine bridges towards Cologne/Bonn Airport, continue along the A 559 and leave at the Am Grauen Stein or Kalk/-Poll exit.






